OUR PROCESS



1. Your Personal Slot

Each student will be assigned a specific date and time for their private session, with scheduling details shared at the beginning of May 2026. A coordinated Friends Group photo will also be arranged in advance.

2. The Best of Both Worlds

We conduct two distinct sets:

Indoor Set: Polished and professional, perfect for the yearbook.

Outdoor Set: Natural and relaxed, ideal for announcements and wall art.

3. The Reveal

Proofs will be available in your private, password-protected gallery 2-3 weeks after the session.

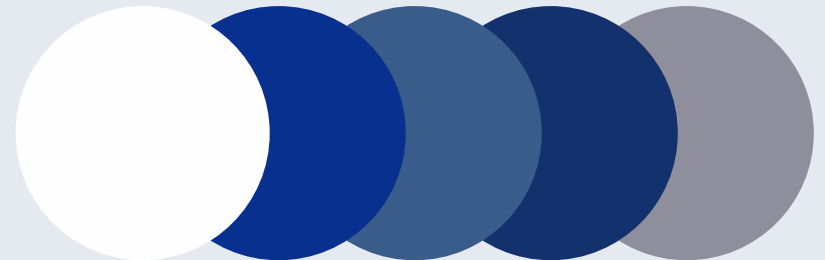
4. Selection & Purchase

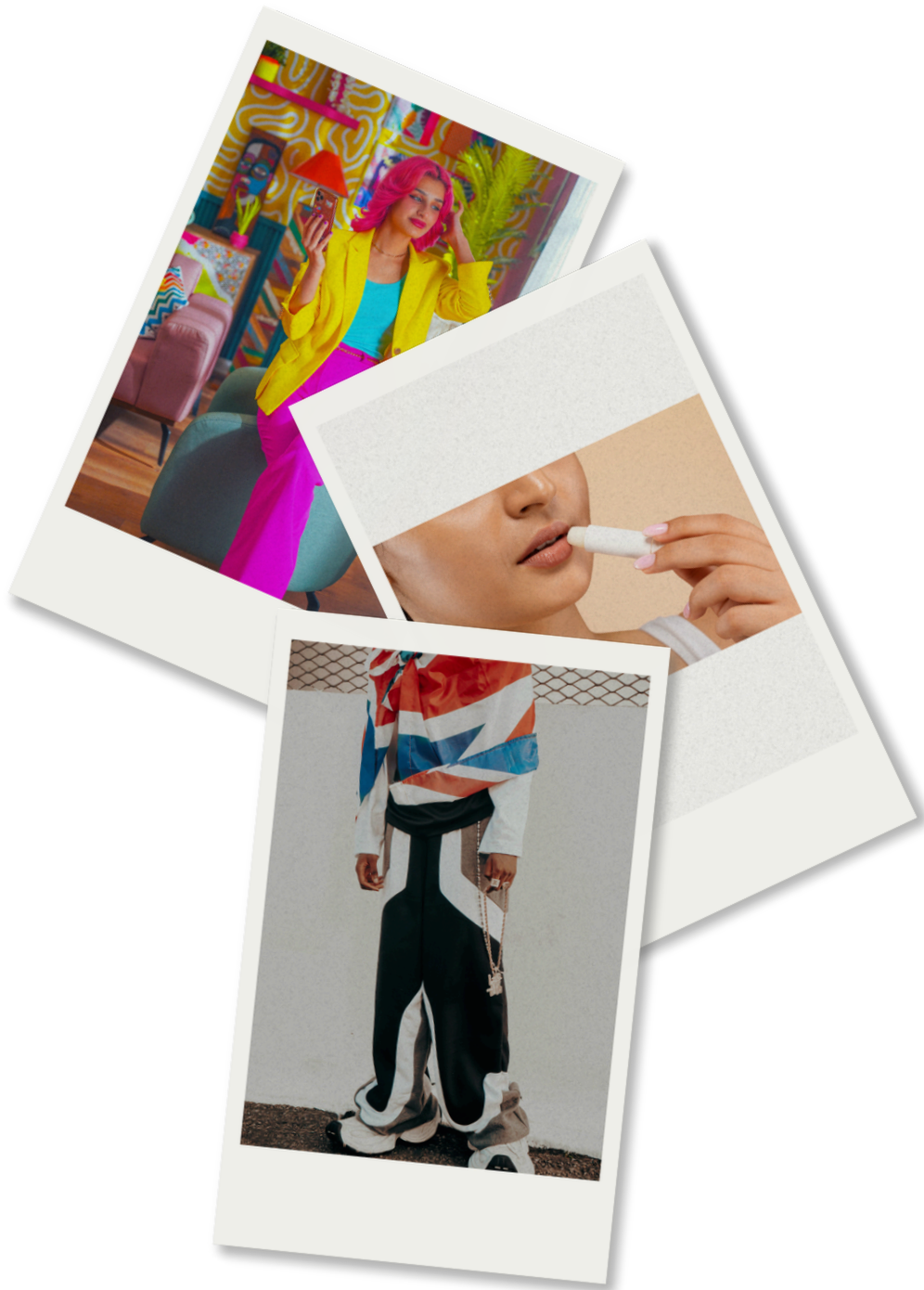
From your gallery, you can view and purchase your favorite images. You'll also use this portal to select the specific photo you want for the school yearbook.

WHAT TO WEAR

The Do's

- ✓ **Steam or iron your gown:** “Factory fold” lines are permanent in photos if not pressed out beforehand.
- ✓ **Follow the Class of 2027 color theme:** Dressing within the class palette creates a cohesive, timeless look.
- ✓ **Check your undershirt:** A simple white V-neck or neutral camisole ensures nothing “peeks out” from under the gown.
- ✓ **Bring a brush and hairpins:** Quick touch-ups between indoor and outdoor sets are lifesavers.
- ✓ **Wear walking shoes:** The outdoor set may involve grass or uneven paths; ensure your footwear is “all-terrain” friendly.





The Don'ts

Avoid neon or “highlighter” colors: These reflect harsh light onto your skin, causing unflattering neon-green or hot-pink “color casting” on your chin and jawline.

Don't forget your Chapstick/Vaseline: Dry lips are very visible in close-ups. Remember to moisturize your lips before your session so they look smooth in the final shots.

Don't wait until the morning of: Try on your formal outfit at least 48 hours early to ensure the fit is comfortable and you feel confident.

Avoid large, distracting logos or prints: We want the focus on your face and your achievement, not a brand name or graphic tee.

Don't forget the cap: It should sit flat on your head, parallel to the floor—not tilted back or to the side. (We'll help you adjust it if it gets wonky!)

FAQ

Do I need to pay before Picture Day?

No. We use a “Proof-First” system. You only pay for the images you love after you’ve seen them in your private gallery.

Can I order both digital files and physical prints?

Yes. We offer high-resolution digital downloads, traditional print packages, and “build-your-own” bundles.

Will the photos be delivered to the school?

Yes, photos are hand-delivered to the school as a precautionary measure.

What if my child is absent on Picture Day?

We coordinate with school administration for a “Retake/Makeup Day,” which your school will announce.

Is my child’s data safe?

Yes. We are fully FERPA compliant. Galleries are hosted on secure, encrypted servers.
